

PhotoSoc Tripod Loan Policy

The tripods will be held in the C&S Office in the Manning Building.

The tripods can be borrowed for three (3) consecutive inclusive uni days by PhotoSoc members. Uni days do not include weekends or public holidays. For example, a tripod borrowed on Monday is due for return on Wednesday, a tripod borrowed on Thursday is due for return on the following Monday.

A tripod can be obtained by asking one of the C&S staff and producing acceptable photo ID corresponding to a name on the PhotoSoc member database (Student card, ACCESS card, Drivers licence and proof of age card are all acceptable). It will then be necessary to sign your name and details in the Tripod Loan book; doing so means that you understand and agree to the terms of the loan outlined in this document.

A deposit of \$50 must be left with the C&S Office which will be returned when the tripod is returned undamaged to the C&S office.

If the tripod is returned after the three (3) day loan period has expired then the deposit will be forfeited to PhotoSoc. This rule will not apply if the hirer obtains written permission from the PhotoSoc executive, before the hiring period has expired, to have to tripod for a longer period of time.

If the tripod is structurally damaged (i.e. its function is impaired) then the hirer will be obliged to pay for any necessary repairs or replacement.

If the tripod is lost then the hirer will be obliged to pay the replacement cost.

If the base plate is not returned with the tripod then the deposit will be forfeited to PhotoSoc in order to pay for a new plate.

The tripod must be returned clean (i.e. no mud etc.) or half the deposit (\$25) will be forfeited.

The tripod must not be used in any corrosive environments (i.e. salt water), due to the possibility of corrosion of the tripod.

Tripods will be loaned out on a first come first serve basis.
